

FPCO Resolution Team Meeting  
December 8, 2011

The FPCO Resolution Team met by conference call. Sam Knight opened the meeting with prayer. The following motions were approved:

1. That the Resolution Team request the assistance of First Presbyterian Church in distributing our notice that the session has submitted a request for a meeting of the congregation on January 29, 2012 to be held immediately following the 10 AM joint worship service and notifying them that the Team will bring that request to the Committee on Ministry and asking the congregation to save the date.
2. That the Resolution Team strongly recommend to the Session of the First Presbyterian Church of Orlando that they not send out their "Discerning God's Way Forward" communication until Tuesday, December 13 so that the FPCO Resolution Team can offer suggestions for possible revision. Suggested revisions should be emailed to Michael Foley by Monday.

Dan Debevoise, the chair of the COM joined our conversation. The COM at their January 5<sup>th</sup> meeting will hear a request from the FPCO Resolution Team to hold a congregational meeting at First Presbyterian Church of Orlando on January 29. He concurred with the Resolution Team that it would be appropriate to send a save the date letter.

Some members of the Resolution Team did not think that all of the questions posed by members of FPCO had been addressed or adequately answered. The members of the team will present possible postings at our next meeting. The Resolution Team will request that the FPCO provide an easier to find link to the questions and answers posted on the Presbytery website.

Some members of the FPCO have expressed the opinion that discussions of settlement options should be held before the vote of the congregation. This will be addressed in more detail at our next meeting. One item not discussed at this meeting due to time constraints was the voting procedure suggested by FPCO. This needs to be on the docket for our next meeting.

The FPCO Resolution Team agreed to meet at the Presbytery office on Friday, December 16 at 10 AM. After this meeting we may request another meeting with the Denominational Relations Committee at FPCO. Meeting closed with prayer by Michael Foley
