



(Who Can Join)


Youth who are:







- 3. By sharing this good food free of charge, with people in greatest need, we care for our brothers and sisters, improving the nutritional values in their diets.










Triennium YOU Has Been Released!

the PMA wrote about a plan to establish some regional online resources to "bridge the gap" to Triennium 2025. PYT Beyond, a new expanded ministry for Presbyterian youth that will offer virtual sessions, cohorts for youth and adults and online courses related to the theme, "When Did We See You?" The first pieces of this program, dubbed "When Did We See You?" for YOU, were released earlier this week.

There are three components; a small group study guide, a recreational guide and a worship guide. The small group study guide has 3 sessions and starts with the Matthew 25 text and builds upon it with other scripture.


