AUGUST 6, 2019

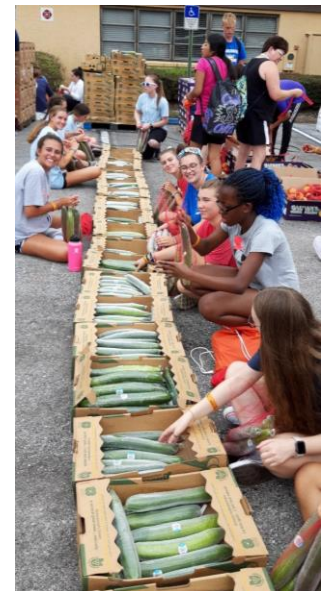
- With the Support and Partnership of PATH/2 Cents Per Meal Offering, Society of St Andrew has saved & distributed over 2.4 Million Pounds of Fresh Produce for the Hungry This Year!
- Citrus, cabbage, cucumbers, broccoli, potatoes, cauliflower and greens kept our volunteers very busy throught the Spring and summer months!
- On Martin Luther King Day we held our 3rd annual gleaning/, cooking demo/hot meal event for the local homeless community. First gleaning fresh crops from Roth Farms with volunteers from FFA and the FL Dept of Agriculture. The produce was then taken to Lighthouse Ministries where we offering simple cooking techniques and tips and then served a delicious hot meal to those in attendance.
- APRIL, MAY AND JUNE ...Our volunteers were back in the fields and groves gleaning corn, peaches, potatoes and cabbage.



- In JUNE SoSA Hosted 120 Volunteers From The VFW & Humana Who Gleaned Over 20,000lbs of Corn From Long and Scott Farms In Zellwood. The corn was picked up by Second Harvest Food Bank.
- Also In June SoSA once again partnered with Southeast Produce Council Members to fill a truck with beautiful produce for people in Kentucky who struggle with hunger.



- On July 13 SEPC donated 23 pallets of onions, peaches, squash, eggplant, cukes, cabbage, etc. to SoSA for hungry people in Florida. 250 students from the Christian Life Youth Conference helped sort, bag and load this beautiful produce onto Second Harvest and Palm Beach County Food Bank trucks, as well as dozens of smaller agencies and church pantry vans and trailers. Thousands of individuals and families were given access to fresh nutritious produce, thanks to all our farmer partners, volunteers, and to Central Florida Presbytery who supports us with a portion of the 2 Cents Per meal offering. Thank you PATH Committee for your faithful support which enables us to help people in need eat healthier!
